**Video overview:** The theme from today's readings focuses on enduring hardships and trials—embracing the crosses that God allows into our lives. In our human nature, we find ourselves resistant to this kind of suffering. We avoid it and anxiously try to change situations that are unpleasant. But God is inviting us to trust him in our day-to-day lives, even when our circumstances are unpleasant or involve difficulty. God is inviting us to share in his passion. This theme comes through clearly in the Gospel reading when Jesus says, "Now is the Son of Man glorified," just as Judas is leaving to betray him. It is precisely through the suffering Christ will face in his betrayal, passion, and death that he is glorified. This is at the heart of our Catholic faith. One of the great mysteries of our faith is that we are all called to share in Christ's glory, by sharing in his suffering. Just as Jesus offers up the poverty of his battered condition on the cross, and God uses it to transform the world, so too we are called to offer up the sufferings and poverty of our lives. When we are willing to embrace the poverties of our day-to-day lives and offer those up in trustful surrender and in union with Christ's sacrifice to the Father, God will transform them into amazing riches.

**Featured study:** Session 7: Self-care

**Reflection:** Because we're less familiar with the Old Testament than would have been Jesus' apostles, we often miss the announcement. Jesus confides, "Now is the Son of Man glorified." Jesus is apparently making reference Daniel 7, where Daniel received a vision in which he saw four beasts representing worldly kingdoms, which are all finally displaced by a heavenly ruler, referred to as "One like a son of man coming on the clouds of heaven," who receives eternal glory and kingship from the "Ancient One." "Son of Man," was Jesus' preferred title for himself. It's also interesting to note that after Jesus mentions his glorification as Son of Man, he gives a commandment—his most important command—to his apostles: "Love one another." We're to love as he loves. Jesus tells them, and us, that his followers will be recognizable for the love they bear for one another. In so commanding, Jesus is exercising the dominion that he receives from the "Ancient One" and passing the source of his glory, which is his self-offering of love, to his followers, "the holy ones of the Most High" who will possess the kingdom. All of this corresponds to the scene in Daniel 7.

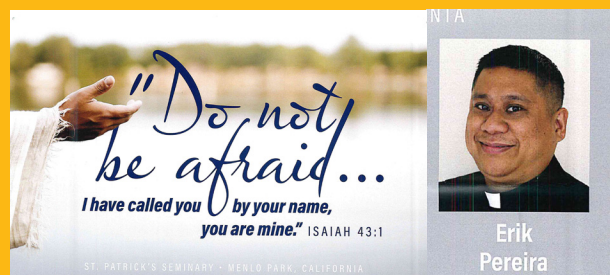

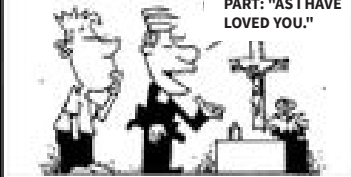

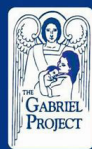

# Youth & Young Adults Corner

Brothers and sisters,

Today we hear about how Jesus gives us a new commandment: “Love one another.” This is how people should know that we are disciples of Jesus, by our love for one another. Tradition says that in the early days of the Church, when St. John was entering his final years of life, he did not have the strength or energy to preach for extended periods. In fact, he often had to be carried around by other believers because of his frailty. He would be placed before the congregation to preach and would preach only one simple and short message: “brothers, love one another.” For the final years of his life, this was the primary message he preached: “love one another.” The problem for the 21st century English speaking person is that we use “love” in such a generalized way that it has lost its meaning. “I love my wife” is not the same as “I love coffee.” The question we need to ask ourselves is this: what does it mean to love? What is love?

To love someone means to will the good for another - not just to want the good for another, but to will that it should happen. Jesus did not just want us to be saved from eternal damnation, he willed that it would be so by giving his life. Love is sacrificial. To love one another, then, means that we willingly sacrifice something of ourselves for the good of the other.

How can you live out this true form of love this week?

## POPE FRANCIS: VOCATION 'IS ABOUT MAKING GOD'S DREAM COME TRUE'

Pope Francis says that when we speak about vocations, we are speaking about making God's dream come true. The Holy Father made the observation in a Message released for the 59th World Day of Prayer for Vocations, which falls this year on 8 May, and has as its theme "Called to Build the Human Family."

"As Christians, we do not only receive a vocation individually; we are also called together. We are like the tiles of a mosaic," the Pope said.

*"Each is lovely in itself, but only when they are put together do they form a picture. Each of us shines like a star in the heart of God and in the firmament of the universe."*

At the same time, he reflected, we are called to form constellations that can guide and light up the path of humanity, beginning with the places in which we live.

The Pope said that when we speak of "vocation," then, it is not just about choosing this or that way of life, or devoting one's life to a certain ministry, or being attracted by the charism of a religious family, movement, or ecclesial community.

"It is about making God's dream come true, the great vision of fraternity that Jesus cherished when He prayed to the Father 'that they may all be one!'"

"Each vocation in the Church, and in a broader sense in society, contributes to a common objective, namely, that of celebrating among men and women that harmony of manifold gifts that can only be brought about by the Holy Spirit."
