**Review:** Fire. It's intense, beautiful, dangerous, overwhelming, warm, and all-consuming. Fire can be used to warm us on a cold night, or as a way to gather friends on a summer evening. It can also yield immense destruction. Fire is powerful. This is the image that we hear about today as we learn more about the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles at Pentecost. At our Confirmation, we too receive the gift of the Spirit. But have our hearts been set ablaze like those of the Apostles? Do we radically and unabashedly share Christ with those around us, setting their hearts ablaze, too?

**Featured study: Lectio: Peter. Episode 8: Peter & Pentecost. The story of how Peter denied Jesus and then is transformed by the Holy Spirit. Great video, and it's only 46 minutes.**

**Reflection:** The giving of the Holy Spirit is not a one-time event. Rather it is like a small river that grows, eventually becoming a mighty river. The scene we are presented with today provides several points for meditation. First, this is a Resurrection scene, reminding us that the gift of the Holy Spirit is inextricably tied to the events of Holy Week. In fact the other reading option for this day is taken from the Last Supper discourse.) Paradoxically, Jesus breathes forth the life of his Spirit at the moment of his death, and enables us to receive that Spirit through his sacrifice on the Cross. Second, this particular giving of the Holy Spirit is specifically for the Apostles. This is when we see them receive a special power-the power of absolution of sins, a power hitherto reserved to God. But this is a gift that the Apostles handed down to their successors. God has chosen to communicate himself through his priests, and we are blessed to frequent the sacraments as an ever-available spring of life. Finally, while there is certainly a clerical aspect to this reading, we should be reminded that for the laity, the power of forgiveness is a special grace of the Holy Spirit. When we struggle to "forgive those who trespass against us," the Holy Spirit is always ready to assist us. What we are powerless to do alone, he will do in us.

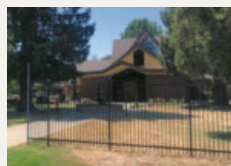

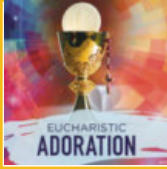

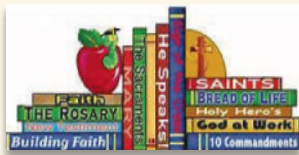

## Bautizos:

## Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

## Matrimonio:

## First Eucharist:

## THE MOST HOLY SEASON!

This past Sunday we celebrated the *ASCENSION of JESUS INTO HEAVEN*. Before leaving, Jesus said to his apostles that He needed to go to prepare a place for them in the house of His Father and that He would send the Holy Spirit to them. This celebration marks the end of our Easter Season and ten days after Jesus' Ascension, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit. Today, Pentecost Sunday, the Holy Spirit comes bringing many gifts for us. Those gifts are: wisdom, counsel, understanding, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. In the Atrium we all celebrate PENTECOST and with lighted candles in our hand, we pray for the special gift each of us wants to receive. Easter is the most holy and beautiful season of the year! We start with EASTER SUNDAY, then ASCENSION SUNDAY followed by PENTECOST SUNDAY, and lastly Sunday of the BLESSED TRINITY; One whole Sunday to celebrate our One God in 3 persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

# OCIA Adult Faith Formation

We live in a cultural moment that's witnessing the sunset of secularism. Rising in the East a new cultural order is emerging. We, God's people, have the Good News — the euangélion — to inform and shape that new cultural order.

When Christianity was first preached "humanity was lifted on a wave of hope... announcing the glad tidings that "the Transcendent God, the friend of man, revealed in Jesus, opened for all of us a way that nothing would ever bar again" and that this message was not limited only to a "small and select company" but meant for mankind as a whole, regardless of ability and social standing." Henri de Lubac, *The Drama of Atheist Humanism*

All of us have friends, family, and coworkers who are caught in this cultural moment. Invite them to get to know this Transcendent God, the friend of man – to know the Good News. Invite and accompany them to OCIA, the process through which adults are received into full communion with the Church.

# Vatican News

## Pope at Regina Coeli encourages growing in friendship with the Lord

In his customary address before leading the recitation of Sunday's Regina Coeli prayer, Pope Francis reflected on Sunday's Gospel theme, recalling Jesus telling the Apostles, "I do not call you servants any longer, but friends." Saying how servants of God are special people in whom God places His treasures - recalling Moses, King David, the prophet Elijah, and the Virgin Mary - the Pope explained how Jesus wishes more for us, something greater, that we be in friendship with Him.

...Real friendship recognizes our common humanity and is not the result of calculation or compulsion, the Pope said, and when authentic, does not fail even in the face of betrayal. Quoting the Book of Proverbs, "a friend loves at all time," the Pope said a true friend does not abandon you despite your mistakes but rather corrects you, or even reproaches you, but also forgives you. Jesus tells us in today's Gospel how we are His friends, dearly loved "beyond all merit and expectation, to whom He extends His hand and offers His love, His Grace, His Word; with whom He shares what is dearest to Him, all that He has heard from the Father." The Lord even becomes fragile for us, the Pope pointed out, "placing Himself in our hands without defence or pretence, because He loves us, He wants our good and He wants us to share in his."

The Pope suggested we think about how we see the Lord in our own lives, whether as a friend or a stranger; and whether we accept His boundless love for us and share it in our own lives with our brothers and sisters, especially those who make mistakes and need forgiveness. He prayed that the Blessed Mother might help us grow in friendship with her Son.
