**Video overview:** The readings for the Easter season harken back to the first days of Christianity. As we read them, we walk in the footsteps of the first Christians as they try to figure out what it means to follow Christ. It isn't as if they had all the rules spelled out for them in some sort of "Be a Christian" manual. They had to rely on the working of the Holy Spirit for guidance and discernment. Take one of the first major questions facing the developing church: Do Christians have to be circumcised? Circumcision was an essential part of the Old Covenant, but was it necessary in the New Covenant of Jesus? After prayerful consideration, the leaders decided that no, circumcision wasn't necessary. That model of discerning the will of God for the Church continues to this day. The Holy Spirit is with the successors of the apostles: the bishops and Pope, the Magisterium of the Church. In accord with Jesus' promise not to leave us alone, the Spirit remains active even to the present time. So, what does this mean to us? It means that through the teachings of the Church, we can be certain that we are following the authentic teachings of Jesus. We can trust that, with the continued guidance of the Holy Spirit, the Church is passing on and protecting those teachings. That's why we need the Catholic Church—to help guide our lives so that we might save our souls for eternity and live happy, fulfilled lives today.

**Featured study:** Proclaim the Gospel to every creature

**Reflection:** Here we see the promise that Jesus made to send His Holy Spirit to "teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." It is this Spirit, which we await anew in our anticipation of the Solemnity of Pentecost, who is the "living memory" and the "principle of every vital and truly saving action" in the Body of Christ, the Church (CCC 798 and 1099; Pius XII, encyclical, *Mystici Corporis*: DC 3808; Cf. John 14:26). The same Spirit which Jesus promised and then sent when he had returned to the right hand of the Father in heaven inspired the apostles to say in their letter to the Gentile believers that we saw in the first reading, "It is the decision of the Holy Spirit and of us..." When the Church speaks through her appointed teachers, the heirs to the office of the apostles, the Pope and bishops, it is the Holy Spirit who speaks to us, teaches us, advocates for us, leading the Church "to all truth" (John 16:13). With the Father and Son, the Holy Spirit comes to dwell in us by Baptism, making each of us a "temple of the holy Spirit" (1 Corinthians 6:19). This surprising promise, that the creator will come to dwell in his creature, is one we ought to constantly return to and rely upon. Great masters of the spiritual life from St. Augustine of Hippo to St. Teresa of Avila remind us that heaven is within us by Baptismal grace. The soul in grace need not go to mountaintops or to the great cathedrals to find God, for he is "more interior to me than my inmost self," and well as "higher than my highest self".

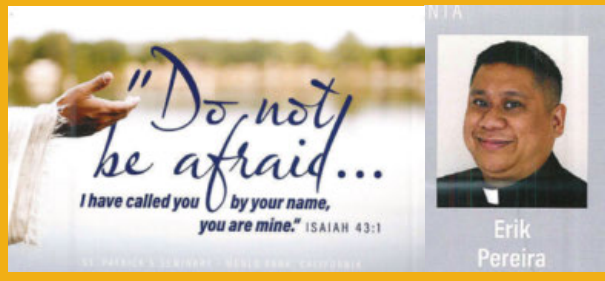

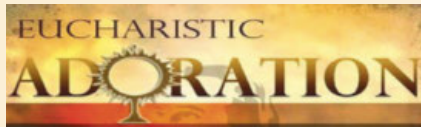

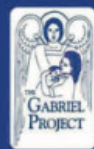

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

## First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

## Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

# Vatican News

## POPE FRANCIS TO GRANDMOTHERS & GRANDFATHERS: "LEAVE A LEGACY OF GOOD RATHER THAN JUST GOODS"

Pope Francis offered advice on Wednesday about how to live in retirement fruitfully by leaving "a legacy of good, rather than just goods."

Speaking during his general audience on May 11, the pope said that retirement can be a "time to leave a good legacy of wisdom, tenderness, and gifts for the family and the community."

"When we think of an inheritance, at times we think of goods, and not of the goodness that is done in old age, and that has been sown. That goodness is the best legacy we can leave," he said in St. Peter's Square.

Pope Francis pointed to how many retirees can devote themselves to the joy of helping to look after grandchildren, providing them with "irreplaceable lessons." But he also noted that "today fewer and fewer children are born, and parents are often more far away."

"When we are old, we lose some of our sight, but our inner gaze becomes more penetrating - one sees with the heart. We become capable of seeing things that previously escaped us ... It is true: the Lord does not entrust his talents only to the young and the strong. He has talents for everyone, made to fit each person, the elderly too," he said.

"The life of our communities must know how to benefit from the talents and charisms of so many elderly people who are already retired, but who are a wealth to be treasured."

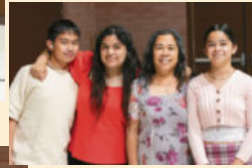
