Review: Have you ever felt a tug to do something out of the ordinary? Maybe say something to someone you've never met before or call up an old friend to check in? This tug can make us feel uncomfortable; we aren't sure why we have this feeling we need to act, but we feel almost disobedient if we don't follow through. Oftentimes, these promptings are from the Holy Spirit, who puts things on our hearts in order for us to be Christ to others. Through Baptism and Confirmation, the Holy Spirit dwells in us. The next time you feel prompted to reach out, be bold in love and ask the Holy Spirit for the gift of courage.

Featured study: Baptism & Confirmation. A 24 min video that will really teach you everything you forgot...and so much more.

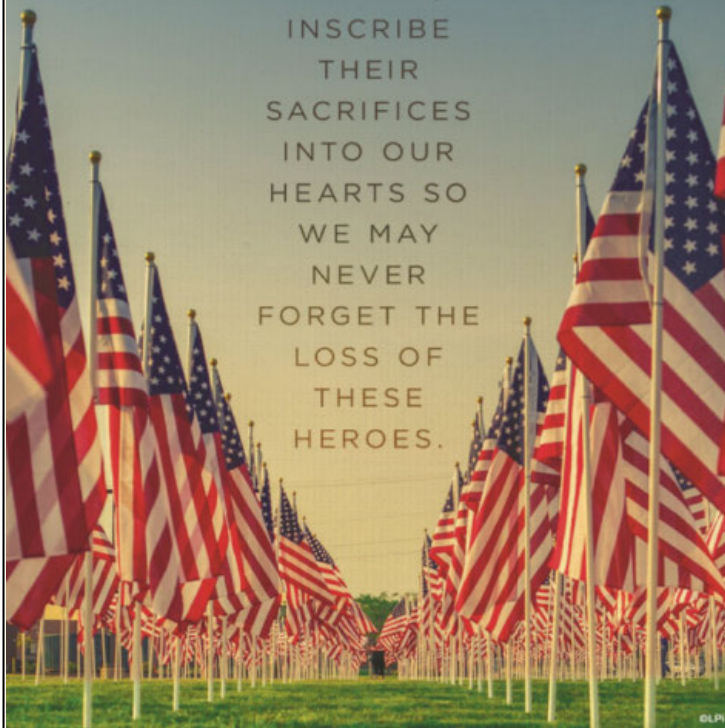
Reflection: The This scene from St. Matthew's Gospel is the conclusion of the whole Gospel and the culmination of the Evangelist's Resurrection account. In obedience to the directive of the Risen Christ, the eleven have come to the mountain in Galilee, where they see Jesus alive again. Here they exhibit a conflict that almost every follower of Jesus can sympathize with: "They worshipped, but they doubted." Jesus's response is consoling; he draws near to them, assures them of his power and divinity, and gives them their apostolic commission. They are to carry on his work in the world: to make disciples, baptize them, and teach them to observe what he has commanded. In other words, they are to reunite the fallen world with God, drawing men back into the life of the Trinity. Some might object that Jesus did not baptize, as another Evangelist notes. However, it is his own "baptism" (see Luke 12:50), that is, his Death and Resurrection, which is communicated in the Sacrament. Hence it brings about an existential change in those who receive it, a truly new mode of being: divine adoption. Teach them to observe all I have commanded you," says Our Lord. This is the formation that follows Baptism. Children who come into a family must learn how to participate in the life of the family, Jesus's final words, "I am with you always," manifest the tenderness of God. God wants a union with his children. All the effort, the sacrifice, the suffering, the establishment of the Church, has this one goal: to bring about God's glory by his children living in joyful, fruitful union with him.

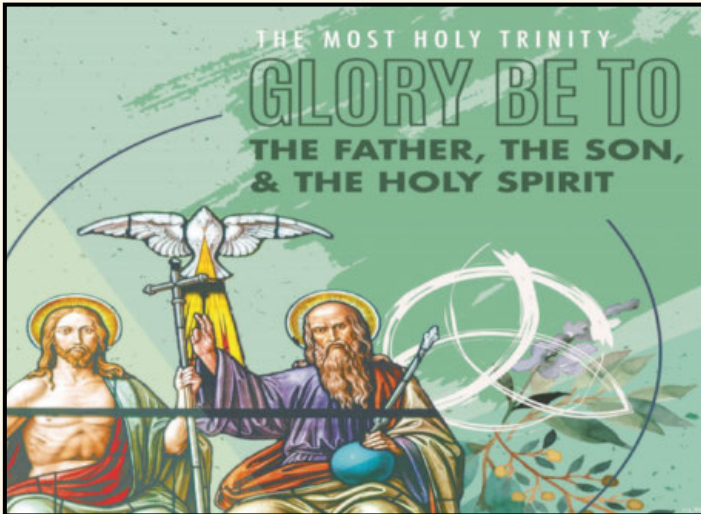

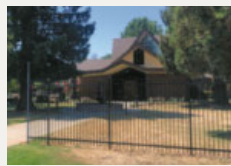

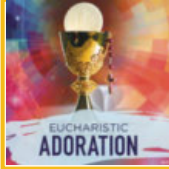

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Pope at Audience: Charity is the work of the Holy Spirit in us

Pope Francis turned his thoughts to the theological virtue of charity on Wednesday as he continued his series of catechesis on the vices and the virtues. He began his reflection with the passage of St Paul: "So faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love." The Holy Father noted that these words were addressed to the Christians of Corinth, who suffered from division and strife – even in the Eucharistic celebration. ...Like every human person, the Pope explained, Christians are capable of "all the forms of love in the world": romantic love, love of friends, country, humanity.

"But there is a greater love," Pope Francis said, "which comes from God and is directed towards God, and enables us to love God... and to love our neighbour as God does." This is the virtue of charity, which enables us not only to love our friends and family, but to love even those people that it is difficult to love. "This is 'theological'," the Pope said, because "it comes from God, it is the work of the Holy Spirit in us." ...But beyond the normal loves and affections of the human heart, he said, "Christian love embraces what is not lovable, it offers forgiveness, blesses those who curse. It is a love so ardent that it seems almost impossible, and yet it is the only thing that will remain of us."

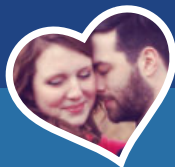

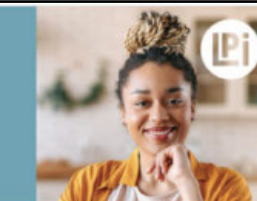
