THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

"Jesus said to his disciples: 'Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day ... You are witnesses of these things.'" - Lk 24:46, 48

Video overview: Imagine you've spent an incredible three years with your best friend. Then one day, everything changes. He tells you that he is going to leave you and won't be coming back. He gives you advice on how to live without him, reassures you of his love, then disappears. How would you feel? The pain would almost be unbearable. That seems to be the exact situation the disciples of Jesus faced in today's Gospel reading. Can you imagine how difficult this situation was for them to see Jesus ascend to heaven and how confusing their task ahead appeared to be?

And yet, Jesus promised them—and he promises us all—that he would never abandon us. Though he ascended to the Father in heaven, Jesus does not leave his disciples alone. He gives all Christians his Holy Spirit, to be our guide and eternal friend. Moreover, he shows them what their reward will be if they remain faithful. Just as Jesus ascends to the Father, so too will we fully enter into God's life if we remain faithful to his promises.

Featured study: Happiness, God, and Man. By Cardinal Christoph Schoenborn

Reflection: These are the final words of Luke's Gospel. They celebrate the event we sacramentally recall and relive today in the Church and point us toward Pentecost, but they also give us an important charge. In our first reading from Luke's Acts, he adds the further detail from the event of the Ascension that Jesus commissioned his followers to "be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Our response to that important call to mission, to what we have come to call the New Evangelization in our own day, depends vitally upon our being "clothed with power from on high," upon our drinking in of the Holy Spirit that Jesus promises us. Note that the disciples are obedient to Jesus' command to "stay in the city", return to Jerusalem "with great joy" and are "continually in the temple praising God." This is what we are charged to do too. We must constantly implore God's grace for ourselves and his Church in the work of mission, which the Catechism calls a "requirement of the Church's catholicity." In order for the Church to be the "Catholic [universal] Church" she needs the Spirit. Once "clothed with power from on high" we, too, will find the joy of those first apostles and the energy to do what we were born in Baptism to do: be "witnesses of these things" "to the ends of the earth!"

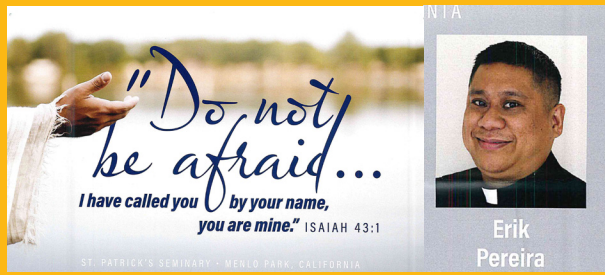

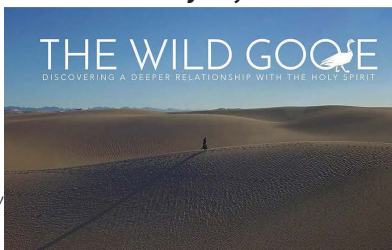

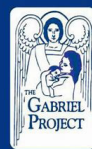

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primer Comunion:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Vatican News

VATICAN HOSTS SYNOD LISTENING SESSION WITH DISABLED CATHOLICS

The Vatican hosted a virtual listening session with Catholics with disabilities on Thursday as part of the Synod on Synodality process.

People from more than 20 countries participated in the video call hosted by the Vatican Dicastery for Laity, Family, and Life on May 19, with some expressing concerns about experiences of discrimination and exclusion.

A participant from France with Down syndrome shared on the call: "At birth, I could have been aborted. I am happy to live."

"I love everyone and I thank God for creating me," she added, according to the dicastery.

Other participants from Mexico, Liberia, Ukraine, and other countries also took part in the discussion of some of the synod's preparatory questions, including: "How are we walking with Jesus and our brothers and sisters to proclaim Him? For the future, what is the Spirit asking our Church to grow in our journey with Jesus and with our brothers and sisters to proclaim Him?"

Cardinal Mario Grech, the secretary general of the Synod of Bishops, spoke to the participants at the beginning of the call.

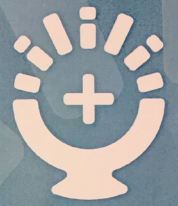
"I'm in debt to people with disabilities. One of them led me on the path of a priestly vocation," Grech said.

"If the face of the disabled brother or sister is discarded, it is the Church that becomes disabled," he said.

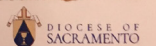

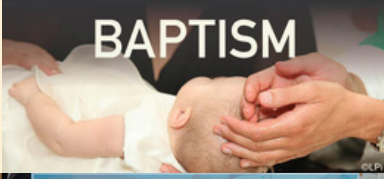
