

Review: Most of us have been either literally or figuratively lost at some time, not knowing which way to go, and feeling a surge of fear and panic. The Apostles in today's Gospel were feeling lost because Jesus had just told them he was going to leave them in order to be crucified and die. Thomas said what must have been in all their hearts: "We do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" Jesus's answer might have been confusing. He didn't give instructions or directions. Instead, he told them that he himself was the direction. He said that he was the way, the truth, and the life. We can understand the meaning of his words only when we realize that he was saying that he was going to the Father and that if we want to go to the Father, we must go through the Son, within the power of the Holy Spirit. That's how our prayers work and that's how blessings come to us-always through the Son. We know Jesus, and in knowing him, we come to the Father. Unlike the Apostles, we haven't had the experience of being physically in the company of Jesus, so how can we get to know him? The answer is simple: through the Holy Mass, by receiving Christ in the Sacraments of the Church, by studying his Word, participating in the sacraments of the church, and through our prayers and devotions. When we do those things, we come to know Jesus. And then we can truly confess that he is our way, our truth, and our life.

Featured study: Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Reflection: This passage points us toward the Ascension. Jesus tells the apostles that he's going to prepare a place for them "in my Father's house." We discover that Jesus is leaving to go to the Father, but he assures his disciples that this absence is only so that he may prepare a place for them. He promises, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way." The last part of that phrase is a reflection of Jesus's Incarnation and mission. He comes to us to dwell with us in time, in the flesh, and in so doing, wins us the ability to dwell with him in eternity. What makes this astounding thing possible is Jesus's unity with the Father in the Holy Trinity. So much of what Jesus promised requires his divinity. Unless he was God, he couldn't save us from sin, he couldn't gain us entry to Heaven, and he couldn't give us his flesh to eat. This is what Jesus reveals in the second part of this passage. "I am in the Father and the Father is in me," Jesus says in language that seems to stretch to the breaking point in trying to convey these divine truths.

GOSPEL MEDITATION MAY 7, 2023




If you had to summarize the essential core of the Christian life, what would it be? Mercy, truth, or love, perhaps? The readings today suggest another word which may surprise you. That word is priesthood.

St. Peter says to us, "You are a 'chosen race, a royal priesthood...'" To be part

of a priesthood is to offer a particular sacrifice in order for the community to survive and thrive. Jesus is the great high priest because he offers the one perfect sacrifice which heals and perfects the entire human race. Peter the Apostle wants us to know that all the baptized share in this priestly ministry. The whole of our lives, including every detail, is meant to become our acceptable offering to God.

The baptized exercise this priesthood in many ways, I'll mention three. At Sunday Mass, in private prayer, and in daily work. At Mass, we offer the sacrifice of our lives with that of the priest, who symbolizes Christ the Priest. In our prayer, a "morning offering" prayer is a great way to offer up all the joys and sufferings of the day to come. In our daily work, we sacrifice our time, comfort, money, and energy to do good for others. All this gives the deepest possible meaning to our lives: we share in the priesthood which saves the world. That's at the core of our faith.

Vatican News

'Pope Francis: The Church is a vocational symphony'

Pope Francis reflects on the theme "Vocation: Grace and Mission" in his Message for the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, saying, "This day is a precious opportunity for recalling with wonder that the Lord's call is grace, a complete gift, and at the same time a commitment to bring the Gospel to others."

The Day of Prayer for Vocations falls each year on the Fourth Sunday of Easter, when the Church reads the Gospel passage of the Good Shepherd (John 10:1-10). The Day is marked this year on Sunday, 30 April.

In this year's Message, the Holy Father emphasizes that each human person is chosen by God, "created by love, for love, and with love, and made for love." Recalling his own call to the priesthood, Pope Francis explains that God's call "tends to make itself known gradually," and one that calls for a response on our part. "Vocation is 'the interplay between divine choice and human freedom' ... God calls us in love and we, in turn, respond to Him in

No vocation without mission

At the same time, the Pope continues, "God's call ... includes a 'sending'. There is no vocation without mission." Pope Francis once again highlighted that every baptized Christian is called "to bear joyful witness" to our experience of Jesus through spiritual and corporal works of mercy. In service to God and our fellow human beings, "we come to understand the heart of the Christian vocation: to imitate Jesus Christ, Who came to serve, not to be (Read more on www https://www.vaticannews.va/en.html) served."





Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunion:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

RCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.
