Video overview: Have you ever watched a herd of animals as they journey toward a destination? It's remarkable that their every move seems to be in sync with the entire group. Whether it's a herd of cows, sheep, or even a flock of geese, the group seems to move as one body. Yet the key aspect that holds these groups together is their willingness to struggle—even suffer—to remain united as one body. Imagine if Christians were united in this way! Our actions, beliefs, and movements would appear as one body, united in a deeper purpose. By uniting in this way, we would demonstrate our willingness to suffer for each other for the sake of deepening our unity as a body of Christ. This has always been the call for followers of Christ. Jesus redeemed all of humanity in himself and even commanded his disciples to "be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you" (John 17:21). And yet theological, cultural, and liturgical disputes have often split the Body of Christ from its intended unity. So how can we achieve a united front? We must not only turn to our eternal good shepherd for guidance, but we must be willing to suffer for our fellow Christians in the hopes of uniting more deeply in Christ's love. This unity will not only draw us closer to each other, but in remaining united we can endure whatever sufferings may come our way, in the hopes that all Christians will be reunited one day with our great king and eternal shepherd.

Featured study: Dumb Sheep

Reflection: As consoling as the image of the good shepherd is to us, those who heard Jesus utter these words picked up rocks with which to stone him. They questioned his status as "Christ" or Messiah, asking for an outright declaration. Jesus protests that he has made his claim clearly, but then extends the image of himself as shepherd to identify himself with the Father. The minds of Jesus' listeners would have been attuned to the association that he was making between himself and God, who had promised to shepherd his people in Ezekiel 34:11. When listeners ask Jesus for a clear declaration that he's the promised Messiah, He responds, "But you do not believe because you are not among my sheep" (John 10:26). In keeping with the division of the sheep that was prophesied in Ezekiel 34, we're told twice in John's Gospel that "there was a division" among the Jews over Jesus (John 9:16; 10:19, RSV). Jesus explains clearly that the determining factor that decides whether or not anyone belongs to the Father is whether or not one "hears" in the words of Jesus the voice of the shepherd prophesied in Ezekiel 34. By following Jesus' voice, we receive eternal life and remain safely in the hands of the Father.

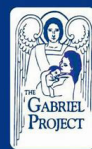

Anointing of the Sick:

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primer Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

POPE FRANCIS THANKS PAPAL FOUNDATION FOR AID TO UKRAINE

Pope Francis expressed gratitude to The Papal Foundation for its efforts to provide aid to Ukrainians suffering amid the war in a meeting at the Vatican on Thursday.

"Your work helps to bring the love, hope, and mercy that the Gospel proclaims to all who benefit from your generosity and commitment. For this I thank you, and I pray that you will be renewed in your zeal to serve our Lord in serving the least of our brothers and sisters, as Jesus himself told us."

The foundation's executive director David Savage told CNA on April 28 that it had recently approved an initial grant of \$100,000 to support the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (UGCC) as it organizes new offices in Lviv, western Ukraine.

"The grant for the UGCC Patriarchal Curia will go towards maintaining Church structures and strengthening institutional capacity so it can better provide large-scale humanitarian assistance and pastoral care in Ukraine during the war," Savage said following the meeting with the pope.

The philanthropic foundation is based in the United States.

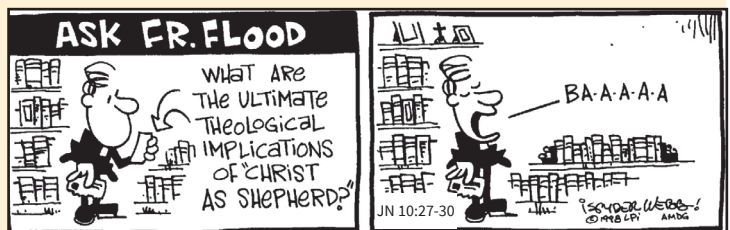

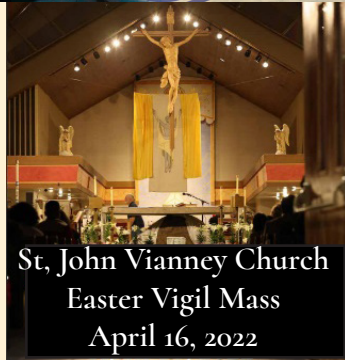
