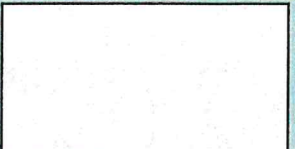

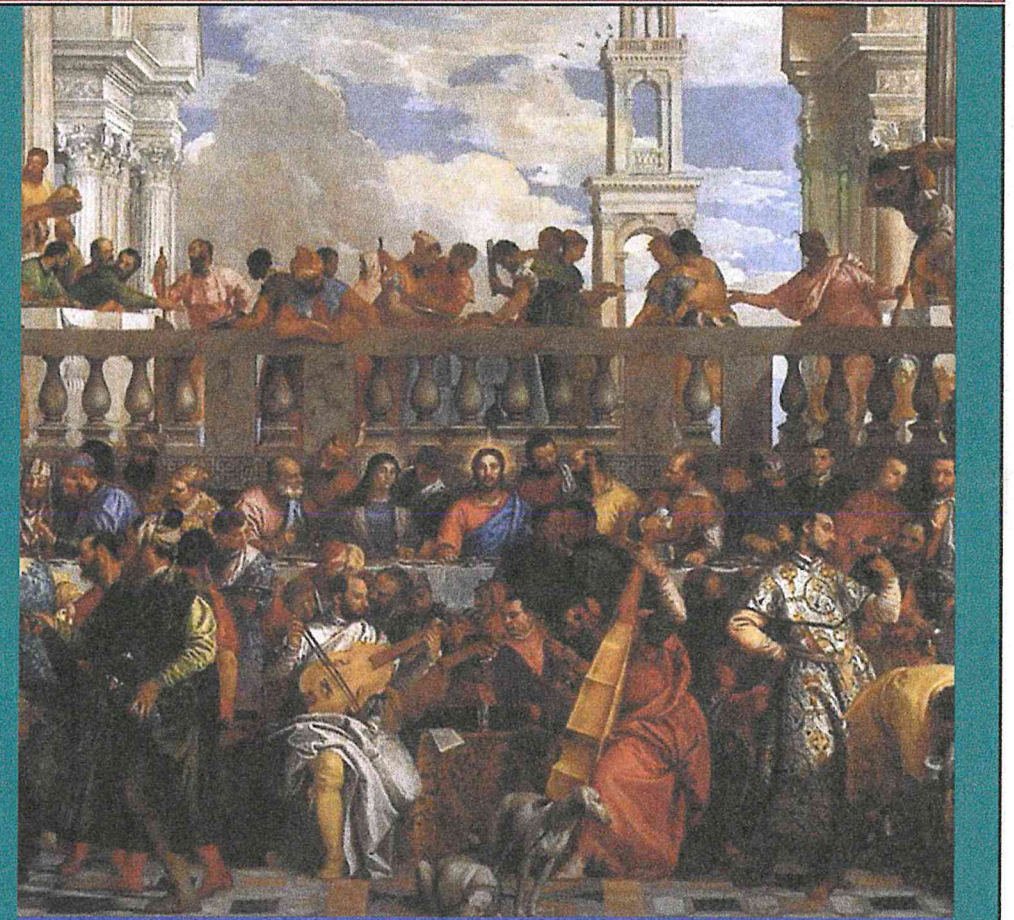

Review: Who doesn't love a party-especially when someone else is footing the bill? Well, in today's Gospel we hear about several people who turned down an invitation to a banquet. And not just any old banquet, but a feast put on by the king! These people even went so far as to kill the servants who invited them. Finally, the king gave up on his chosen guests and opened the banquet to anyone who wanted to come. While we might think this is an interesting story, it would have been more than that to Jesus' audience. He was speaking to his enemies, the priests and elders. As he told this story, they couldn't have helped but relate the king to God ... and perhaps their own actions to those guests who refused to enter the banquet. This story must have struck them where it hurt, so to speak, if they realized that they, as the leaders of the Jews, might not be responding fully to their King, God. Little wonder that they began to call for Jesus' death-to get him off their backs. But we aren't completely off the hook. We, too, have been called to the new banquet of the King-the one in which everyone is invited through the death and resurrection of Jesus. This new banquet is the family gathering of all the people of God, and it finds its fullest expression in the Mass. God wants us all to join him at this banquet table, but sometimes, like the guests in the parable, we make excuses and find other things to do. If we truly believe that God is the King who invites us, then we should come quickly and joyfully to attend the feast that is the Mass each Sunday.

Featured study: The Eucharist by Dr Scott Hahn

Reflection: The "reign of God" is thought to have been a current phrase to represent covenant faithfulness. So, when Jesus begins a parable, "The reign of God may be likened to ..." and then goes on to describe a gross affront to "a king" by invited guests to a wedding banquet, we can guess that the message got through. The Pharisees, who regarded themselves as impeccably faithful to the covenant, seem to have taken some offense to this parable. It's vital that we get an accurate assessment of the attitudes of the Jewish people in response to Jesus because we've been incorporated into Israel by grace. If we see Jews in the Gospel as merely a caricature of stubbornness to the overtures of God in Jesus, we're unlikely to recognize ourselves and our own covenant shortcomings in them. The city that Jesus says the king will send his army to destroy is the one we inhabit. It's the city we live in, not merely the Jerusalem of old. We Catholics are now the invited guests to the banquet. We're invited each Sunday in anticipation of the wedding feast in heaven. Jesus has won and offered redemption for all, but we can only enter into that redemption by our choice to be redeemed.

Pope Francis to hold meeting with children at the Vatican on Nov. 6



Pope Francis on Sunday announced a meeting with children to be held at the Vatican on Nov. 6.

The event in the Paul VI Audience Hall, sponsored by the Dicastery for Culture and Education, will be dedicated to the theme "Let us learn from boys and girls."

"It is an event to show the dream we all have: To go back to having the pure sentiments of children because the kingdom of heaven belongs to them," the pope said after praying the midday Angelus on Oct. 1.

Accompanied by five children from five continents, the pope on Sunday said that children "teach us how to be transparent in relationships, how to welcome strangers, and how to care for creation."

Sunday also marked the feast day of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, whose "little way" of holiness is the subject of a new apostolic letter Pope Francis will publish on Oct. 15. Following his Gospel reflection the pope spoke briefly about the document, calling the "Little Flower" a saint of trust. "May St. Thérèse help us to trust and to work for the missions," he said.

The apostolic exhortation will be released on the feast of the saint for whom Thérèse is named, St. Teresa of Avila.

American novelist Flannery O'Connor once said, "If it's just a symbol, to hell with it," in response to a friend who described the Eucharist as a "pretty good symbol."

"Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life. I am the bread of life. Your ancestors ate the manna in the desert, but they died; this is the bread that comes down from heaven so that one may eat it and not die. I am the living bread that came down

from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world....."

We will be discussing The Eucharist, and the Liturgy of the Eucharist in our ninth session of OCIA, the process through which adults are received into full communion with the Church, on Sunday, 22 October 2023.

Anointing of the Sick:

By appointment.

Unción de los Enfermos:

Con cita previa.

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunion:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.
