Review: It is helpful to understand the context in which Jesus was speaking when he taught in parables. In the case of our Gospel passage this week, Jesus had been preaching and teaching in the Temple when the chief priests and elders began questioning his authority. In response, Jesus tells them about two sons who are asked to work in their father's vineyard. For us to fully understand what he was saying, we need to realize that whenever a vineyard appears in the Old Testament, it is an image of Israel. So, Jesus is really challenging his audience to look at how they, as the leaders, have been "tending" the people. Have they been saying one thing and doing another? Have they been like the second son, talking respectfully and lovingly to God, but then acting willfully and arrogantly? Or have they been like the first son, who rebels in words but then repents and does the father's will? In this story; one question we can ask ourselves is this: Are our actions speaking louder than our words? However, Jesus doesn't just leave it at that. He always goes beyond convicting us of our faults to invite us to repentance and humility. The entire message of the Gospel is that the mercy of God is always available, but God cannot forgive an unrepentant heart. When we are locked in willful pride, we are unable to repent. But when we recognize our sinfulness, then God can do great things for and through us. However, it's not enough for us to just give lip service to repentance. We actually have to become repentant. We have to act, not just talk.

Featured study: Vianney Speaks: The sermons of the Cure of Ars

Reflection: It's possible to read the two sons in this parable as the Jewish and Gentile peoples respectively, but there's a deeper point that transcends that historical one. In every age of the Church, there are those who say yes to God but then don't follow him and those sinners who see their sin and repent of it. Jesus suggests to the officials that the conversion of the tax collectors and sinners at the preaching of John should've signaled his authenticity as a prophet. If the sinners are converting, take note, he tells us. That's the sort of fruit one ought to see from God's work. Neither Jesus nor John is particularly harsh with sin. They correct it, certainly, but it's only to unrepentance that they show scorn. Jesus can cleanse us from sin, but he doesn't have any cure for unrepentance. The unrepentant invariably see themselves as first and the whole offer of salvation as unnecessary: They'll be the last to enter the Kingdom, if indeed they're able to enter at all, because the King himself is suspect to them. The King is a Savior and if you have no need of the Savior, you'll not get the King or his Kingdom, either.

Synod 2023: What has Pope Francis said about synodality?



The Synod on Synodality is set to launch the first of two assemblies on **Oct. 4**.

The global meetings in Rome are the culmination of two years of preparation, and during that time, much has been said about synodality, including by the pope.

In some of his more recent comments on synodality, Pope Francis said, "speaking of a 'Synod on Synodality' may seem something abstruse, self-referential, excessively technical, of little interest to the general public," but it is "something truly important for the Church."

"Precisely at this time, when there is much talk and little listening, and when the sense of the common good is in danger of weakening, the Church as a whole has embarked on a journey to rediscover the word together," he said to media representatives on Aug. 26.

"Walk together. Question together. Take responsibility together for community discernment, which for us is prayer, as the first Apostles did. This is synodality, which we would like to make a daily habit in all its expressions," he added.

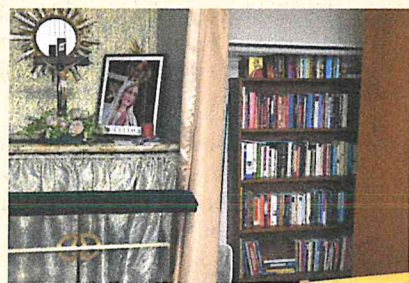

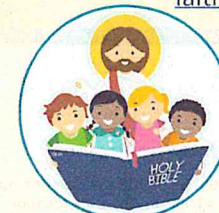

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Confirmación para Jóvenes:

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

OCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.

OCIA y Sacramentos para adultos:
