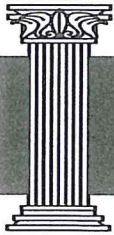

Dear Parishioners:

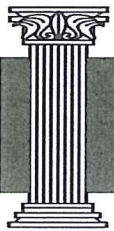
Before Easter I was talking with one of our students who is from Kenya. We were on the playground and he was telling me how exiting Easter is there. "We go to Mass and sing, dance, and do Mass," he said. "Then we visit and eat in the afternoon. It lasts the whole day. You're tired when you get home, but it's fun."

The Early Church saw Sunday in this way. They worshipped at Mass, then continued their fellowship to bring the community together by studying in their families with lay leaders. The Jews did, and still do, something similar on their Sabbath. They study the Torah Scriptures, celebrate a feast together and share over the meal each family's needs, dreams, confessions and celebrations.

This model melds heavenly life with earthly family life in a beautiful way. We were created for melded lives, with Jesus at the center of all our human activities, and us consciously aware of his presence throughout our days. Next week we will introduce you to FORMED. I pray this on line program will bring study and worship together for us on Sundays, and then will develop into a one night a week parish wide study that will create a Christian life style of union with Christ. That will help us be more fully the Body of Christ.

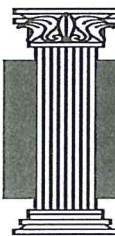

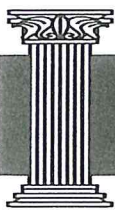

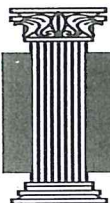

Stewards of Vocation

Jesus calls us, as his disciples, to a new way of life—the Christian way of life—of which stewardship is part. But Jesus does not call us as nameless people in a faceless crowd. He calls us individually, by name. Each one of us—clergy, religious, lay person; married, single; adult, child—has a personal vocation. God intends each one of us to play a unique role in carrying out the divine plan. The challenge, then, is to understand our role—our vocation—and to respond generously to this call from God. Christian vocation entails the practice of stewardship. In addition, Christ calls each of us to be stewards of our personal vocations, which we receive from God.
