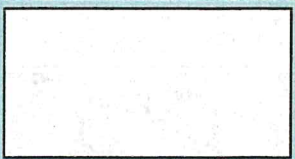



# FORMED

## OUR VISION

**Review:** "My thoughts are not your thoughts nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord." Perhaps no story in the New Testament proves the truth of that statement more than today's Gospel. In the parable of the workers in the vineyard, we are confronted with what we might consider an unfair situation. The owner of the vineyard goes out and hires workers, starting in the early morning and ending close to sundown. But no matter what time of day the workers are hired, all get the same daily wage, even if they only worked for one hour. Most of us probably will think how very unfair it was that some had to labor all day and others got to waltz in at the last minute, but everyone got the same reward. In fact, the characters in the parable felt the same way and most likely so did Jesus' audience. But that's what makes the parable so powerful. It's only after we work through our thoughts and feelings about what is right and what is wrong that we can begin to see beyond the apparent unfairness to the character of the owner, who is a symbol of God, and realize that Jesus is telling us that no one is left out of God's love. Once we are able to move on from the "injustice," we are then able to give thanks to God for what he has given us and realize any feelings of envy or comparison to others reflects not on God's generosity but on our own poverty of spirit.

**Featured study:** Discerning God's Will

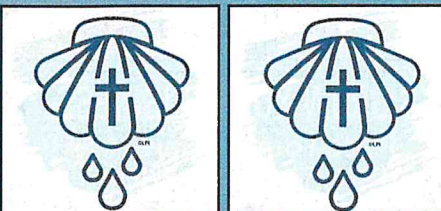
**Reflection:** We might assume in this reading that Jesus is referring to eleventh hour or deathbed conversions. We might also read it as a parable about the inclusion of the Gentiles, the nations beyond the borders of Israel, in the saving plan of God. But another reading, one we might call a mystical reading, would suggest that Jesus is simply telling us that God's plan itself isn't always subject to human calculation. It isn't that it's irrational, but rather, unpredictable. The only thing to trust is that all will be ordered for not only his will, but also for our good. He alone has the capacity to order all of time, even those parts of it which seem to represent the worst in human tragedy or even human sin, in perfect accord with our best interest. The one thing that the Bible ought to teach us is that when we're dealing with God, we should be prepared for surprises. This isn't to say that God will defy his own laws, but he isn't shy about violating ours when conviction, culture, or convention might stand in the way of his plan or our own good. And again, his will is always consistent with our good.

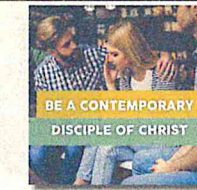

## Irish-born founder of Boys Town, Father Flanagan, may soon be declared Venerable

A Catholic priest reputed for rescuing homeless and impoverished children on the streets of Omaha, Nebraska, is expected to soon be declared Venerable by the Vatican, placing him on the path to canonization.

Father Edward J. Flanagan, who died in 1948, was an Irish-born priest whose saintly life has been narrated in a recent documentary, "Heart of a Servant — the Father Flanagan Story." In a follow-up interview after the film's premiere on July 26 in Sligo, Ireland, Bishop Kevin Doran of Elphin, Ireland, told CNA that there is a good reason to hope that Flanagan will soon be declared Venerable by the Vatican.

Reflecting on the life of the heroic Catholic priest, Doran told CNA that Flanagan "rescued children from homelessness and poverty in Omaha and provided a place for them that they could call home."

He continued: "Father Flanagan is a saint, not just because he did these things but because he was motivated to do so by a deep personal relationship with God.

"Inspired by the same spirit of respect for others as the children of God, he opposed racism and sectarianism, even at great personal risk. He also reached out to refugees and especially children displaced by war. In truth, he 'laid down his life' in imitation of the Good Shepherd."

When asked which causes Flanagan might become patron of should he eventually be canonized, Doran said there were several, in his opinion. (Read more on: <https://www.catholicnewsagency.com/news>)

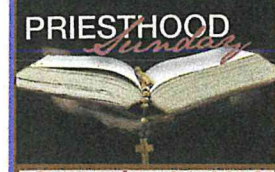

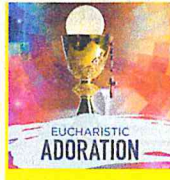

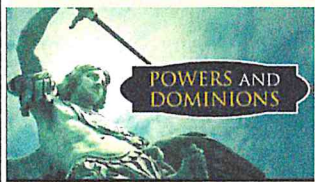

## Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

## Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

## Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

## Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

## First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

## Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

## Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.
