
Dear Parishioners:

Last July I subscribed our entire parish to a tremendous on-line Catholic program called **FORMED**. With over four thousand videos, books and programs, it has the ability to help a parish form itself in Christ, to 'put on the mind of Christ,' as Paul encourages Christians to do in Romans 12:2. I have been remiss in its implementation, and for that I apologize. We will introduce FORMED to you at the Masses on April 21. I'm excited for this opportunity to grow together as God's family.

The Second Vatican Council stimulated a widespread Catholic recovery of the Bible. Theologians, pastors, catechists, and others learned anew to see Scripture as fundamental, not just as a privileged source of revelation but also as a resource for faith formation and the spiritual life." Bishop Robert Barron, one of our Church's most recognized personalities and theologians, says that it was actually something of a discovery for him that a Catholic priest could also be an expert on the Bible. "When I was a kid, I remember this was the sixties or seventies, there was a series of paperbacks that were done by Fr. Raymond E. Brown," he says. "There was this picture of Brown on the back of the book with his glasses on, and his Roman collar, and there he was reading an ancient manuscript. That picture had a big impact on me. There's this priest, this really smart man who knows the Biblical languages, and he's pouring over ancient manuscripts. That a priest would know all these high-level things, I thought it was just cool."

God communicates himself to us principally through the Sacraments, the Scriptures, and the Teachings of His Church. I pray FORMED will deepen our experience of these life pillars. God bless,
