Dear Parishioners:

Last week I wrote about a new program for our parish called **FORMED**, which we will introduce to you by video at the Masses April 21-22. We need Formed because the Church believes we need to remember the readings after leaving Mass. Our lives would be forever enriched if we talked about those words during the week. Studying the Bible is different from simply listening to it on Sundays. Our families deserve to experience the Bible, not simply as information, but as a love letter written by our heavenly Father for our benefit and growth. The Church wants us to have an intimate knowledge of the Scriptures. Formed will help us do that.

We also need Formed because we are a family of Christians who must live and grow together. Families have basic norms of conduct that keep them strong and healthy. Formed will allow our parish, as family, to move in a unified direction toward God's will as He forms our minds, our families, and our parish.

Lastly, we need Formed because it is what the early Church did, what the Jews still do, and what many Christian denominations do today. In the Early Church Christians spent Sunday together. They shared food, teachings, and stories for several hours before celebrating the Eucharist. Today, it is normal for Jews to attend Saturday worship and formation, which they will then teach to their children during the week. From their beginnings, Baptists and many other Protestant denominations have gone to Bible study on Wednesdays, and fellowship and teaching on Sunday before going to worship at church.

May Formed be a blessing for all of us. Happy Easter!

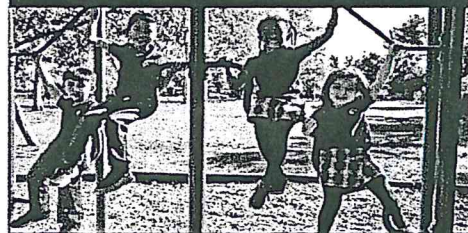

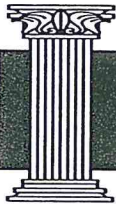

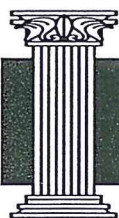
