<u>Video overview:</u>: Depending where you live in the country, winter can be very depressing since you may not see the sun for two or three months. The temperature can be bone-chillingly cold, and there is little sign of life except for the brave neighbors shoveling their driveways. The days are short and dark, the trees are lifeless, and we don't hear children playing outside or birds chirping. It can seem very desolate. Carrying our cross is often a "winter" for our soul. It can be challenging, lonely, and may seem never-ending. The hope that we have in Christ is like hoping for the springtime. We carry our cross and die to ourselves so that we can experience the Resurrection with him. Just as flowers bud and blossom again, the trees grow leaves, and the sun grows warmer in the springtime, so too do our souls become nourished and refreshed when we give ourselves entirely to Christ. But, in order to experience this beautiful springtime, we must first go through the trial of winter.

**Featured study:** The Grumpy farmer and the cheerful farmer.

Topic of Interest: : Today's Gospel is not a "feel good" teaching. Take some time to answer Jesus's question to his disciples: "Who do you say that I am?" Write down your answer. If Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, then to whom else can we turn? Next, take some time to recognize the cross or crosses you are facing. How can you "take up your cross" this week? What will change in your attitude towards these trials? Write down your commitment. If you need to post it on your bathroom mirror as a reminder, do so! Use your Prayer Journal to write down your thoughts, your reflections, and your resolutions. It is not easy to take up our crosses and follow Jesus, and it is not a decision that we make suddenly and then habitually do it with perfection. Every day, several times a day, we will probably need to re-commit to embracing the cross in our lives at that moment and ask Jesus to fill us with his grace. Reminders throughout our home, office space, car, etc. can help us to stay focused on our goal of following Christ. Place a small cross or an image of the crucifix in these places so that you remember who you are following and how you are to follow him.




#### **ON FIRE 2021**
